

Notice of Lead Service Line Material Inspection Survey

In July 2021, P.L.2021, Ch.183 (Law) was enacted, requiring all community water systems to replace lead service lines in their service area within 10 years. Under the law, the Pompton Lakes Municipal Utility Authority is required to notify customers, non-paying consumers, and any off-site owner of a property (e.g., landlord) when it is known they are served by a lead service line. Our service line inventory is available at www.plbmua.org. Our Inventory records do not have all of the materials of the service lines in our system. A Pompton Lakes Municipal Utility Authority Employee will be visiting all residents in town and either doing an inspection survey of your service line or leaving a door hanger for the resident to complete the service line inspection survey. We are asking for the resident's assistance when asked to complete the survey to protect their own and the communities drinking water system.
